MEETING AT VILLA CA' CORNARO PARK IN THE FATEBENEFRAPELLI INSTITUTE at 7 a.m. via Ca' Cornaro No. 5, 36060 Romano d'Ezzelino (VI) at the border with Bassano del Grappa, near the junction of the superhighway at the exit to Romano North pointing to Cima Grappa.

DEPARTURE from 7:30 am to 9:30 am at your own pace and open to all. There is no need to run since the course can be done as a walk or stroll. We advise you not to leave earlier than 7:30 am, the facilities may not be ready, and the insurance is not yet activated.

AMPLE PARKING has been arranged within the Park with spaces reserved for buses.

CLOSING CEREMONIES will take place after the arrival of the last participant, but not before 2 pm.

PLACE OF ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE within the Villa Ca' Cornaro Park, where in the adjacent little church a Holy Mass will be celebrated at 11 am.

COURSES: 5-7 Km flat, nature, 11 and 20 Km mixed hilly, 26 Km with 8 Km across the mountainous part of Valle Santa Felicità with an altitude of 670 meters (this course is beautiful but demanding, recommended for experts of mountain terrain, not suitable for minors.)

RUSTIC CORNERS shown again and can be seen along the march with scenes of rural life from the last century.

Presence of Nordic Walking Specialty; manner of participation can be found by consulting the website www.montegrappa.org.

REST AREAS are numerous and well furnished, portable chemical toilets all along the course of the Walk.

REGISTRATION FOR INDIVIDUALS until 9:30 am Sunday, November 8, 2009.

REGISTRATION FOR GROUPS until 8pm Saturday, November 7, 2009 with a minimum of 20 participants. Discounts for groups beyond 100 registered participants, and for groups from outside the Veneto Region or groups from other countries.

ACCOMMODATIONS with hotels for reduced prices have been prearranged for this event.

FREE SCREENING is offered to the participants of the march who ask to be treated for skin Melanoma by medical specialists from the University of Padua, Oncology Center of Veneto.

No donations will be requested from children younger than 10 years.

A clown will be provided to entertain the children upon arrival.

Minors must be accompanied by their parents and in any event may participate under the direct responsibility of the ones with parental authority.

The donations from the participants will not be subject to I.V.A. (value added tax) according to regulation of article 4, second, fourth, sixth subsection of the D.P.R. 633/72 (Presidential Decree) and subsequent amendments. These donations will be finalized at the completion of the event, the subject of this pamphlet, in direct implementation of the institutional intent according to the meaning of article 2, first subsection letters a) and b) of Dlgs 460/97 Legislative Decree) and the third subsection 148 of TUIR (Italian Constitutional Tax Act).

BEGINNING OF AWARDS, to the groups about 10:30 am; the school children with the largest number of participants in relation to the number in their class will be awarded prizes in conjunction with a school holiday.

ASSISTANCE, ambulance, doctor, civil defense, clean-up services, and crossing controls by personnel from the organization.

CONTROLS will be enforced along the course.

INSURANCE accident policy No. 1102230 and RCVT No.1102229 (Rehabilitation Cardiovascular Technology) for the organizers.

THE PROCEEDS will be assigned to charity, partly for educational initiatives within the school and partly in support of the charitable Association U.T.A. onlus (non profit organization) and partly to the project of voluntarism of the constituent International Benefit Association Greg Voluntary and Charitable World Wide (I.B.A.G.) and the establishing a fund for earthquake relief for Aquila, and for a food bank for needy families.
